

SECTION 24 -

Eve of Destruction World Famous Trailer Racing Rules

1 GENERAL EVENT DESCRIPTION

The intent of this event is good, cheap, fun competition. Competitors making it more than that by spending Un-due amounts of time and/or money on car preparation will be discouraged from competing.

2 CAR ELIGIBILITY Specifications

Meridian Speedway Officials will determine whether a car meets the applicable specifications for the Event.

Only cars determined to meet the applicable specifications are eligible to compete in the Event.

3 Competitor Obligations / Inspection Prior to Race

If a Meridian Speedway Official determines prior to the race that the car does not meet the applicable specifications, the car will not be allowed to compete unless, in the discretion of the Official, the deficiency:

- (a) Will not adversely affect the orderly conduct of the race;
 - (b) Cannot be corrected in time for qualifying for the race;
 - (c) Will not provide the Competitor with a significant competitive advantage over other Competitors; and
- Q (d) Is so insubstantial as not to warrant a determination that the car is ineligible to race. If the Official permits the car to compete under these circumstances, the Official will apprise the Competitor of the deficiency. If the deficiency has not been corrected, the car will be prohibited from competing.

4 DRIVER RESPONSIBILITIES

All drivers in this Event must attend the pre-race drivers meeting(s). A thorough explanation of that day's particular event rules will be made. YOUR ATTENDANCE AT THESE MEETING(S) AND YOUR COMPLIANCE WITH THE RULES EXPLAINED IS ABSOLUTELY MANDATORY.

This applies regardless of how many times you have competed; things may change between events!

5 TRAILER RACE REQUIREMENTS

Any full size tow vehicles will be approved, cars, pick-up trucks, vans etc... NO CONVERTIBLES, OR OVERSIZED VEHICLES

Tow vehicles must be stripped of all side glass. Windshields or screen must be in place.

It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that all interiors be stripped of flammable materials (rugs, headliners, door panels, bottom of rear seat, etc.).

ALL exterior lights and body moldings must be removed.

Heavy wire mesh must be installed over the entire windshield opening if windshield is removed.

It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that a wire mesh or a racing type window net be installed over the driver's window opening.

Battery must be securely fastened in its stock location.

Radiator reinforcements are highly recommended

Drivers door must be welded shut.

ROLL CAGE or Roll Protection is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

Tow vehicle must display a one or two digit number the full height of the door on each side of the car for identification purposes.

If your vehicle has an air bag, it must be disconnected.

All trailers and tow vehicles must be empty of all trash and debris before entering the track surface, this will be checked by a Meridian tech official

6 DRIVER PROTECTION

Helmets are mandatory, Fire suits HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

Leather gloves and footwear mandatory.

Seatbelts are mandatory.

7 TRAILER HITCH

Standard receiver / stinger / 2" or smaller ball set up may be attached to the tow vehicle by directly welding or mechanically fastening (bolting) to the frame or bumper.

A standard ball may be directly welded to the bumper of the tow vehicle.

Trailer will be required to detach from the tow vehicle at the request of officials.

Pintle hitches will not be allowed.

8 SAFETY CHAINS

Maximum of 2 safety chains are approved.

Must be bolted or welded to bumper or hitch only on vehicle side.

Must be welded or bolted to the trailer in a location not further than 3 feet from the ball location. Tech approval

9 TRAILERS

Any type of trailer is permitted, however open flatbed trailers must be loaded.

Be creative, themes are what makes this a "fun" race.

Trailer must be at least 1" taller than the vehicle that is towing it.

Promoter/Official discretion will be final.

10 EVENT RULES

Any time a car/truck becomes separated on the track, that car will be deemed unable to compete for the remainder of that race.

Trailer (frame) must remain intact from hitch through and including at least 5 ft of the tongue or frame or it will be deemed unable to compete for the remainder of that race.

Pre notching or cutting frames/ tongues is prohibited.

Hits to tow vehicles are not allowed.

Competitors who make an intentional hit to another competitor's tow vehicle, or an un-trailer tow vehicle will be disqualified from competing for the remainder of the race.

11 ENTRY FEE

Will be waived to any trailer race vehicle that displays a sign reading "Trailer Race SATURDAY NITE Aug 3rd Meridian Speedway" or has those words spray painted on the side of it and was displayed during the week prior to the race at a venue of high traffic in a town near you!!!!

12 AWARDS

Event winner - \$300, Is the last car running and in tact as per event rules. If more than one car is running and time has run out purse will be split amongst running cars.

The Master of Disaster - \$100. Is the competitor who inflicts the most damage to the other competitors trailers, connected or not
This award will be determined by the crowd.

Best Design \$100. Is the competitor who comes up with the most creative design or scheme? Award will be determined by the race officials or crowd.
